Questions 1, 3, 4 and 5 are examples of questions with verb tense errors.

As does question 8 that also changes active and passive voice in incorrect answers.

Question 2 uses verbs incorrectly leaving the text without a main verb.

This is also seen in both questions 6 and 9 which also include verb tense issues. Question 7 is an example of subject-verb agreement.
